Have you ever wanted to create YouTube videos? Make stained glass ornaments? Learn to make bots and program drones? Learn to photograph and turn your photos into framed art? Shoot off rockets and fly and shoot aerial photos from drones? Make and program bots - including one to take home? Create animated videos? These and more are offered in the Bedford County 21st Century Community Learning Centers **STEAM into Summer 2019 Camps**.

One and two-week sessions are open to all Bedford County students who will be in grades 6-12 in Fall 2019. The Camp is completely **FREE and transportation will be provided to and from your home schools***. **Sessions will run Monday through Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.**

Program descriptions

- **Culinary (#1A and #2A)** – Explore the different careers available in the food and hospitality industry while gaining cooking skills in this hands-on camp. Want to be the world's next Top Chef? This is a great place to start. Former restaurateur Lynn Baer will be the workshop leader.
- **Wet Paint (#1B)** - Artist Edgar Degas said "Art is not what you see, but what you make others see." In this camp you will be able to experiment with new techniques in alcohol ink, watercolor, acrylic, and mixed media painting. You will also get to stretch your own canvas and learn how to make your artwork gallery ready. Let your imagination run freely! Working artist Janelle Cogan will lead this workshop.
- **All About Bots (#1C)** - A drone and robot boot camp. Control robots and fly drones. learn the basics of coding and controlling machines to complete challenges and even make a bot of your very own to take home! Working designer Michael Corle will lead this workshop.
- **Stained Glass (#1D, #2D, #2E, #3D and #3E)** - You will learn to design and will create your own stained glass ornaments to take home in this fun camp. Stained glass artists (and Northern Bedford site coordinators) Betsy Feight and Laura Fisher will be the workshop leaders. These are one-week workshops. Students may repeat with preference given to first-time participants.
- **Video+Music+Art=Audience (#2B and #3B)** - Learn how to become the next Youtube sensation! In this fun camp led by Tussey Mountain After 3 Coordinator Nikki Gephart, participants will learn to make their own videos that combine video, music, photos and art to engage an audience. Workshop will be offered twice, students may repeat but preference will be given to first time participants.
- **Animator Camp (#2C)** - Create fantastic worlds and bring to life imaginative characters in our Animator Camp! Students will learn different styles of animation including claymation, stop motion and digital vector animation. Students will develop skills in character and set design, camera work and animation principals like timing, anticipate, squash and stretch and more! Working designer Michael Corle will lead this workshop.
- **The Art of Photography (#3A)** - Photographer Ansel Adams said "There are always two people in every picture: the photographer and the viewer". In this camp, you will learn how to take pictures of everyday things in a new way. You will be able to find hidden beauty in ordinary subjects that will tell an extraordinary story. This camp also uses photo editing and photo transferring to display your work. Workshop leader: artist Janelle Cogan will lead this workshop.
- **Rockets (and drones) Away! (#3C)** – Students will have an opportunity to build and launch a variety of rockets, program indoor drones and Sphero robots, and fly remote control drones outside while shooting aerial photos and video, all while learning about aeronautics and developing technology skills. After learning the basics, students will use these tools to work cooperatively to complete tasks. Northern Bedford site coordinator Betsy Feight will lead this workshop.
- **SAT Prep (#3F)** - Prepare for the SAT's in the fall through this 4-day prep focusing on the verbal portion of the test as well as test-taking strategies. Participants will receive test-prep books to take home. Instructor: Bedford coordinator and Latin teacher Patrick Neff. Open to 10th-12th graders.

Remember, space in the 2019 STEAM into Summer Camp is very limited and sessions will be filled on a first-come basis, with some consideration given to geographic distribution.

STEAM Into Summer 2019 camp sessions are open to all Bedford County youth who have completed 5th-11th grade in the 2018-19 school year.
